OVERVIEW

ACOs are Emerging Powerful Stakeholders

Accountable Care Organizations are the equivalent of joint ventures between healthcare providers, the federal government and other commercials interests. Among the cast of players are physicians, medical groups, health systems, hospitals and insurance companies. They have come together voluntarily to give coordinated, high quality care with the goal of creating efficiencies, reducing costs, decreasing errors, and improving outcomes against an assigned population of patients. ACOs promote accountability by tying healthcare provider reimbursements to quality metrics.

Under ACOs, decision making is more centralized and monitored. ACOs have significant control over decisions related to formulary, treatments, health IT adoption, sales-rep access, drug sampling policies, new product uptake and more. With so much at stake, service providers must understand how to position themselves in the eyes of these new and powerful stakeholders. A knowledge of their geographic coverage area, number of participants and ownership model is key to future engagement tactics and collaboration.

OneKey's ACO Reference and Methodology

IQVIA, through its OneKey reference database, has identified over 1,000 federal, commercial and Medicaid ACOs, representing an estimated 28 million beneficiaries and rising.

IQVIA leverages ACO roster membership as reported by the ACO. Some ACOs report professional roster, others report organizational rosters, and still others report a combination of both. As of February 2018 IQVIA has obtained professional rosters from 636 ACOs representing 281,000 affiliations; and organizational rosters from 526 ACOs representing 14,000 affiliations.

In addition to the ACO roster membership, IQVIA captured CMS-reported quality metrics for the ACOs. These metrics include details on preventative health, the patient to care giver experience and details about specific at-risk populations such as diabetes and coronary heart disease.

In this report, IQVIA presents the 30 largest ACOs ranked by the number of total participating healthcare facilities, and the leading ACOs in each of the five ACO types and models.
